# SURFACE BLASTER - (COAL) West Virginia Reciprocal Agreement

## PRIOR TO SCHEDULING EXAM MUST PROVIDE LETTER OF GOOD STANDING FROM RECIPROCATING STATE

Article 3 of the <u>Coal Mine Safety Laws of Virginia</u> establishes requirements for certification of coal mine workers. The certification requirements are included in §45.2-515. through §45.2-534. in which the Board of Coal Mining Examiners is established for the purpose of administering the certification program. The Board has promulgated certification regulations 4 VAC 25-20, which set the minimum standards and procedures required for Virginia coal miner examinations and certifications.

### CERTIFICATION CLASSIFICATION: \*Surface Blaster (Coal) - West Virginia RECIPROCITY Renewal must be in accordance with BCME Requirements

This certification authorizes the holder to perform blasting operations and to record blasting examination information concerning blasting operations at surface mines.

**NOTE:** This certification shall not be used in lieu of any other certification.

#### **APPLICATION/EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS:**

- Application (DM-BCME-1) and \$40.00 fee
- One year of blasting experience (Form DM-BCME-2) on a surface mine under the direction of a certified surface blaster or appropriately related work experience approved by the Chief of the Division of Mines. NOTE: Experience must be submitted within 5 years of passing the examination. After 5 years records are destroyed. Must reapply if future certification is desired.
- Hold a General Miner Certification
- Current first aid training (MSHA 5000-23 Annual Retraining or New Miner Inexperienced Training acceptable)
- Copy of current West Virginia surface blaster card
- Letter of "good standing" from state of West Virginia
- Reciprocity can only be used one time to achieve certification
