Exam Instructions: You are required to read the scenario below and complete the required attached forms as part of your inspection.

You are a Virginia Mine Inspector assigned to inspect various coal mines in accordance with the Coal Mine Safety Laws of Virginia.

On January 23, 2004, you traveled to A&B Coal Co., Inc., Mine No. 2, Mine Index No. 19111AC to conduct an inspection. This drift mine is located off State Route 64 in Wise Co., Va., producing coal from the Splashdam coal seam.

Upon arrival at the mine site, you are met by Earnest Brown, Mine Superintendent, Person with Overall Responsibility and in Charge of Health and Safety. Mr. Brown informs you that he had an ignition in the No. 2 entry working face on the B Left active section at approximately 7:15 A.M. Joe George, first class mine foreman (certification No. 00121), is the section foreman for the B Left active section.

During your inspection, the following conditions were observed on the B Left active section:

- The roof control plan had not been complied with in that the No. 3 entry working face was left cleaned up and a reflector or readily visible warning device was not conspicuously placed at the last row of permanent roof supports.
- An ignition occurred in the No. 2 entry working face of the B Left active section, 60 feet inby survey station no. 1212, following a fall of roof material inby supported roof following the mining cycle.
- The Eimco continuous mining machine, serial no. 11111, was not maintained in permissible condition in that the left ripper motor - electrical cable outer insulation had been damaged.
- The methane monitor for the Eimco continuous mining machine, serial no. 11111, was not properly calibrated when tested.

All violations and closure orders will have an issue date of January 23, 2004.
