Certified pollution control equipment and facilities are declared to be a separate class of property and shall be exempt from state and local taxation. Such property shall include solar energy equipment, facilities, or devices, and energy storage systems capable of absorbing energy, storing it for a period of time, and redelivering that energy. **All equipment must be owned or operated by a business.** Virginia Energy shall determine whether such facilities, devices or systems qualify for certification under [Code of Virginia § 58.1-3660](#) based on the information provided on this application and attested to before a notary. Greater than 5 MW and less than 150 MW for which an initial interconnection request form was filed with an electric utility or a RTO on or after January 1, 2019. *(80% exemption)*

Energy storage systems greater than five MW and less than 150 MW

By signing below in the presence of a Notary Public the applicant certifies that all information is truthful and correct and that the equipment, facilities, or devices for which certification as pollution control equipment is requested complies with all statutory requirements. Virginia Energy reserves the right to physically inspect any and all solar energy and energy storage equipment, facilities, or devices.

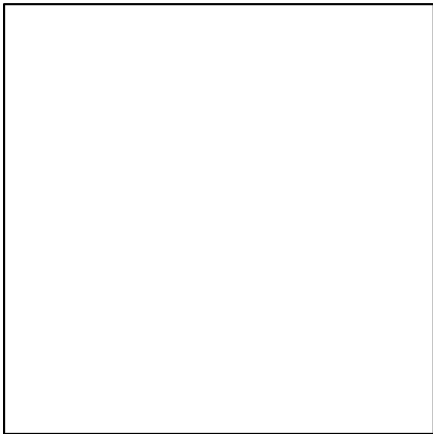
